How does the prophet describe God's peaceful kingdom? + Isaiah 11:1-10  <b>7</b>	In this 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of Advent we think about peace. Today spend a moment remembering children who live in war zones. Ask God to keep them in His care.  <b>8</b>	One way we prepare for Jesus is by being peacemakers. 
