## Maths for Summer 2

### **Geometry: properties of shapes & Geometry: position and direction; Measurement:**

Recognise right angles and know they are  $90^\circ$ ; understand angles are measured in degrees; recognise  $^\circ$  as the symbol for the measurement of degrees; name and list simple properties of 2D shapes; begin to understand and use the term perimeter to mean the length/distance around the edge (border) of a 2D shape; begin to calculate using a ruler; know a right angle is a quarter turn; know  $360^\circ$  is a full turn; begin to understand angles and identify size of angles in relation to  $90^\circ$

### **Statistics**

In this topic, children learn to read and interpret information presented in pictograms, building on their learning from Year 2. Children ask and answer questions about information presented in both horizontal and vertical pictograms. Encourage them to think carefully about why a particular symbol has been chosen and its relationship to the data being presented. It is important that children understand the value of each symbol and what it means when a half, quarter or three-quarter symbol is used. An understanding of the key is therefore a crucial element of understanding the data. Children revisit and extend their knowledge of constructing their own pictograms
