Dear Parents,

Hoping you have all had a good week.

We started this week on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November attending the Burnham Memorial Service at the Cenotaph at Burnham Park Hall. Two of our pupils, Shai and Amber, represented the school by laying a wreath in remembrance of all those who have died in war but also for those that we remember in our own hearts.

On Monday, the children had an assembly about remembrance and this was followed by a two-minute silence at 11am. The children all created poppies which were put together to create our school displays.


