Maths for Spring 1

<u>Written multiplication and division</u>: Multiply numbers between 10 and 25 by 1-digit numbers using the grid method; divide multiples of 10 by 1-digit numbers using known times tables facts; see the relation between multiplication and division

<u>Mental addition and Subtraction</u>: Use counting up as a strategy to perform mental subtraction; subtract pounds and pence from five pounds; use counting up as a strategy to perform mental subtraction of amounts of money; subtract pounds and pence from ten pounds.

<u>Fractions</u>: Identify 1/2s, 1/3s, 1/4s, 1/6s, and 1/8s; realise how many of each make a whole; find equivalent fractions; place fractions on a o to 1 line; find fractions of amounts

Measurement:

Length and perimeter measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/ cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml). Measure the perimeter of simple 2D shapes.

<u>Problem Solving:</u> Within each of the strands above, the children will continue to develop their problem solving skills.
