Maths for Advent Term 2

Multiplication and Division

Children will multiply and divide numbers mentally drawing upon known facts. They will multiply and divide whole numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.

Next, they will identify multiples and factors, including finding all factor pairs of a number, and common factors of two numbers. Recognise and use square numbers and cube numbers and the notation for squared (2) and cubed (3).

Solve problems involving multiplication and division including using their knowledge of factors and multiples, squares and cubes.

Know and use the vocabulary of prime numbers, prime factors and composite (non-prime) numbers.

Fractions

Children will identify, name and write equivalent fractions of a given fraction, represented visually, including tenths and hundredths. Recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert from one form to the other and write mathematical statements > 1 as a mixed number. Compare and order fractions whose denominators are all multiples of the same number. Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator, and denominators that are multiples of the same number.
