#### **Maths for Lenten 1**

Multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a one or two digit number using a formal written method.

Divide up to four digits by a 1-digit number using the formal written method of short division and interpret remainders appropriately for the context.

Solve problems involving multiplication and division, including using their knowledge of factors and multiples, squares and cubes.

Multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers, supported by materials and diagrams.

Solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities, including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number.
