#### Wildlife area unveiled

We were delighted to orchestrate the opening of the school's newly renovated conservation area.

Thanks to Elite Landscapes, the overgrown site was completely cleared to make way for a safe wooded area, log seating and a pond on the school grounds.

BBC presenter and conservationist Steve Backshall sent the school a personal message to congratulate us all on providing a "special little haven for wildlife."

The area will be used to enhance the children's understanding of science, wildlife and the environment, but will also provide a calming sensory space. Friends of OLOP have set up a bug hotel in the area and we hope to install wildlife cameras and a weather station in the future to maximise learning opportunities.
