The success of the previous year's fundraising has meant that we are able to regularly fund resources requested by school. Since the beginning of 2025 we have been able to provide:

- £3000 towards the cost of 31 iPads to be used by all year groups
- •£430 to pay for dictionaries and thesauruses for years 5 & 6
- £250 for PSHE resources for Children's Mental Health Week. We have paid for an olive tree for each year group which will be a focus for mindfulness activities throughout the vear.
