As part of our Science topic, we will be looking at Sound! This will include how sound is made, pitch, volume and insulators of sound.

Do some research in the local library or on the internet. You can conduct your own experiment learning which materials conduct sound the most effectively and which materials do not. You could learn about the human ear and how sound travels from the source to your ear.

Remember you can be as creative as you like. You may want to add envelopes with hidden information, flaps with questions and answers.

Maths for Pentecost Term 2

Statistics

Pupils will interpret and present discrete and continuous data using appropriate graphical methods, including bar charts and time graphs. They will solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in bar charts, pictograms, tables and other graphs.

Shape

Pupils will identify acute and obtuse angles and compare and order angles up to two right angles by size. They will compare and classify geometric shapes, including quadrilaterals and triangles, based on their properties and sizes. Pupils will identify lines of symmetry in 2-D shapes presented in different orientations. They will complete a simple symmetric figure with respect to a specific line of symmetry.

Position and direction

Pupils will describe positions on a 2-D grid as coordinates in the first quadrant. They will plot specified points and draw sides to complete a given polygon. Pupils will describe movements between positions as translations of a given unit to the left/ right and up/ down.
