Maths for Lenten Term 2

Length and Perimeter

Pupils will understand that kilometres are greater than metres and are used to measure greater distances, make links to counting in 1,000s as covered in their earlier learning on place value. Children will explore perimeter further with a focus on rectilinear shapes, calculating the perimeter of rectangles using the side lengths, finding missing side lengths. Thy will also investigate regular and irregular polygons.

Fractions

Pupils will recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions. They will count up and down in hundredths; recognise that hundredths arise when dividing an object by one hundred and dividing tenths by ten. Pupils will solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities, including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number. They will add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

Decimals

Pupils will recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths. They will find the effect of dividing a one or two digit number by 10 or 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths. They will solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places. Pupils will convert between different units of measure [for example, kilometre to metre]
