As part of our science topic, we are learning about living things and their habitats. One of our focuses will be how environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things. Maths for Pentecost Term 1

Decimals

To compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal places. Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number. Recognise and write decimal equivalents to $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$. To find the effect of dividing a one or two digit number by 10 or 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths.

Money

To estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence. To solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.

Time

To read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12-and 24-hour clocks. Solve problems involving converting from hours to minutes; minutes to seconds; years to months; weeks to days.
