Dear Parents,

It has been a week of celebrations.

On Wednesday, we celebrated our School Feast Day. The children spent the day considering their own personal pledge and discussed together a whole school collective pledge as part of our work towards the Jubilee Year. This pledge is to encourage us all to think about how we can continue the mission of the Church and live out our Catholic Social Teaching. We held Mass outside together as a whole school community with Fr Amal celebrating Mary our Mother, Patron of our school and also celebrating our Year 6 leavers. Following this, we then gathered as a whole school on the field to recreate an image of the school's name and cross. To end the day, the children were treated to an ice lolly provided by the Friends of OLOP.

We have also had the pleasure of watching Year 6 perform their end of year production, 'Rock Bottom'. The children worked incredibly hard to put together a show with brilliant singing and acting, with plenty of humour. Well done Year 6, you should be incredibly proud.

On Tuesday, we received the Year 6 SATs results. Well done to all of the pupils for their ongoing hard work and also to the staff who continuously strive for the best of the pupils. I will share the results in more details in a separate letter.

## WAKE UP WEDNESDAY

Al isn't just transforming the way we learn and work, it's also reshaping the tactics scammers use online. From generating convincing phishing emails to fabricating influencer videos, criminals are using Al to make their scams more convincing than ever. Young people, who often embrace new tech quickly, can be especially vulnerable.

This guide highlights several AI-enabled dangers – including romance scams, deepfake audio and video impersonations, and fake job offers – and explains how to spot and report them. With clear tips for verifying content, thinking critically, and using trusted platforms, it's essential reading for parents and educators to help young people stay one step ahead of the scammers.
