Maths for Summer 2

Written multiplication and division:

Multiply numbers between 10 and 25 by 1-digit numbers using the grid method; divide multiples of 10 by 1-digit numbers using known times tables facts; see the relation between multiplication and division.

Fractions:

Identify $\frac{1}{2}$ s, $\frac{1}{3}$ s, $\frac{1}{4}$ s, $\frac{1}{6}$ s, and $\frac{1}{8}$ s; realise how many of each make a whole; find equivalent fractions; place fractions on a 0 to 1 line; find fractions of a shape and amounts.

Measurement:

Children will learn to read and understand Roman Numerals, and analogue and digital clocks. They will be using the 12 and 24 hour time systems. They will also learn to measure using mass and capacity millilitres and litres, grams and kilograms.

Geometry: properties of shapes & Geometry: position and direction; Measurement:

Recognise right angles and know they are 90° ; understand angles are measured in degrees; recognise $^\circ$ as the symbol for the measurement of degrees; name and list simple properties of 2D shapes; begin to understand and use the term perimeter to mean the length/distance around the edge (border) of a 2D shape; begin to calculate using a ruler; know a right angle is a quarter turn; know 360° is a full turn; begin to understand angles and identify size of angles in relation to 90°
