

Maths for Advent Term 1

Number and Place Value

Making sure that children can read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words. Identifying and representing numbers, correctly recognising the place value of each digit in a two digit number (tens and ones). Learning to count in steps of 2, 3, 5, from zero and in 10 from any number forwards and backwards.

Addition and Subtraction

Learning fact families using addition and subtraction to 10, 20 and number bonds of tens to 100. Children will learn to solve a range of calculations including, adding and subtracting: tens, two 2 digit numbers and three I digit numbers.

Shape

Recognising 2D and 3D shapes, learning the properties of shapes and lines of symmertry.



Log-in to your 'My Maths' account your teacher will be putting activities on My Maths for you to complete.

The Importance of Times Tables:

We all know that learning time tables is an essential part of your child's mathematical education. Children who have mastered their tables gain a solid foundation in mathematics that will help them throughout their progression within the subject. Many children are able to recite in order their timetables, but to truly know the answer to any times table question independently is a skill that takes a lot of hard work. The national expectation is that every child will be able to answer any times table question mentally within a five second period.

Expectation:

By the end of Year 2 children should know the 2, 5 and 10 times table (knowing the 3 times tables is encouraged). Please practice these each week with you child. There will be a times table quiz during the last week of the term.
