School Uniform and bags


- The weather is getting colder so please remember to send your child in with a suitable coat and hat and mittens as we play and learn outside daily.
- If you have not done so already, please send your child in with a pair of clearly labelled wellies.
- Please label your child's uniform. Please may we also ask that children wear school shoes, not trainers.
- Please provide a bag of spare clothes, as sometime children may need to change, due to a toileting accident/ engaging in messy/water play throughout the day.
- Please send your child to school with their reading books in their maroon book bag every day. They take home letters and any crafts they have done in their book bags too.
- Remember to send your child with a labelled water bottle every day.

Phonics



This half term we will continue to look at phase 1 elements of phonics in addition to learning out first few phonics sounds.

This week we are learning the sound 'm' as in man. We will be looking at different pages from the online Floppy Phonics books and seeing where we can find images that being with the 'm' sound. We will be writing the letter by following these directions (start at the top go down, up and over down, up over down and flick). We will be looking at words and use our robot voices to sound them out for example m-a-t mat



Please remember to read with you child and sign their reading record book each time. Please bring the reading record and book in daily in the maroon book bag. Children's books will be changed on **Thursdays**.

Please note this week the reading books will be collected in. Please read a range of books with your child over the holidays and share verbal stories with then also for example 'The night before Christmas'. Write the books you have shared with them in their reading record and anything they may have said about the pictures in the books you have been sharing.


The lilac books are wordless to build up spoken vocabulary and storytelling language. Discuss the pictures in the book and allow them to make up the story from what they can see encouraging the use of full sentences. There are also comprehension questions at the backs of the books which will give you an idea of some of the question you can ask your child when reading with them.

Literacy



This week we will taking about the nativity story and sharing a range of different festive texts and songs with the Nursery Children including how many sleeps till Chirstmas and the 12 days of Christmas

At home share traditional Christmas stories with your children including those that are special to your culture.



Maths



In maths this week we will be completing a range of different winter and chirstmas themed number and shape activitites recapping the learning we have done in maths over the half term such a counting the pom pom baubles on to the chirstmas tress using tweers.

At home sing lots of different number songs and rhymes and count down the days till Christmas



RF



This week in RE we will be thinking back on all of the different things we have been learning on our topic of Phrophercy and Promise this half term. We will think about the nativity story and advent and engage in a range of different festive activities and crafts. We will be asking the children what they wonder about for example what do angels look like?

At home think about how you prepare and celebrate at this time of year. How can you give

back to the community at this time of year and give thanks for all you have?
