Maths for Advent Term 1

Place Value

Pupils will find 1,000 more or less than a given number. Children will recognise the place value of each digit in a four-digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens and ones). They will order and compare numbers beyond 1000.

Children will identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations. They will round any number to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000. Children will solve number and practical problems that involve all of the above and with increasingly large positive numbers. Towards the end of the unit, pupils will count backwards through zero to include negative numbers.

Addition and Subtraction

Children will add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction where appropriate. They will solve addition and subtraction two step problems in contexts, deciding which operations and methods to use and why.
